

Three Hannoveraner Champions in Luhmühlen Hannoveraner Championships of young eventing horses

Verden. At the third edition of the Hannoveraner Championships of young eventing horses, Dora GS and rider Paula Fatteicher took the title in the four-year-old class. The five-year-olds were won by Diacondiva and rider Ann-Catrin Bierlein, while the six-year-olds were won by Diadina and rider Andreas Dibowski. The venue was Luhmühlen.

The four-year-olds determined their champions in test for riding horses with cross-country jumps. The Dancier/Floriscout-daughter Dora GS (breeder: Bernd Gehrdau-Schröder, Stelle) and Paula Fatteicher convinced all along the line with a score of 8.6. On this occasion, the talented bay was awarded the candidacy for the Hannoveraner Premium. Second place went to Calia by Carridam/Quaid (breeder: Klaus Dierks, Ahnsbeck). Only in this year's January, the bay found a new owner at the Verden auction. Anna von Beauvais presented her masterfully and was rewarded with a final score of 8.5. Third place went to Harmony CB by Helium/Samba Hit (breeder: ZG couleur de bohème, Watt/SUI) and Anna-Luisa Millies (7.9).

The horses born in 2018 competed in a cross-country test for young horses class A**. With a lead of 0.30 points, the Diacontinus/Sunlight xx daughter Diacondiva (breeder: Johannes Hilmer, Rullstorf) and Ann-Catrin Bierlein took the title of Hannoveraner Champion (8.80). The Hannoveraner premium mare gave birth to a foal last year before she came to the successful young rider's stable in Warendorf. Two talents shared second place with a score of 8.50: Booze Buddy by Balou Peggio/Valentino (breeder: Heinrich Reisinger, Gersten), who was the best four-year-old in Rüspel last year with

Wiebke Jaspers in the saddle, and Kasparow by Karajan/Diacontinus (breeder: Friedrich Thiesse, Steimbke) with Antonia von Baath.

It was pouring with rain when the Diarado/Silvio daughter Diadina (breeder: Dieter Jennrich, Seevetal) and Andreas Dibowski started in the cross-country test for young horses class L. The two mastered the demanding course with ease and won the yellow and white winner's sash of six-year-olds with a score of 8.80. The team Olympic champion had discovered the Hannoveraner premium candidate at the November auction in Verden last year. The Valentino/Heraldik xx-daughter Viva L'Amour (breeder: Heinz-Dieter Kullmann, Zetel) followed in second place. Trained carefully by Nadine Marzahl and already placed at the Bundeschampionat, she received a score of 8.40. The successful trainer had two reasons to celebrate, she also sat in the saddle of Deliah IOH by Diacontinus/Escudo (breeder: Ira and Olaf Hagemann, Stade, 8.00). The typey grey mare was third after finishing second last year.
